3 DAY WORKSHOP ON DISASTER MANAGEMENT

INAUGURATION - ROAD ACCIDENTS - FIRST AID

The 3-Day Workshop on Disaster Management was held 08-09-2018 to 10-08-2018 at Government Degree College Rayachoty]. This workshop aimed to enhance participants' understanding of disaster management, focusing specifically on road accidents and first aid techniques. Day 1: Inauguration & Introduction to Disaster Management

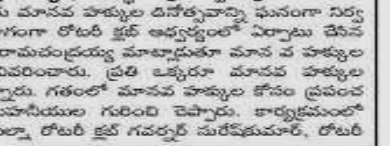

- Poetry and Songs: Students performed poems and songs celebrating the beauty of mathematics and the legacy of Ramanujan.**



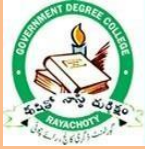

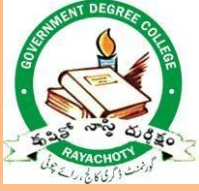

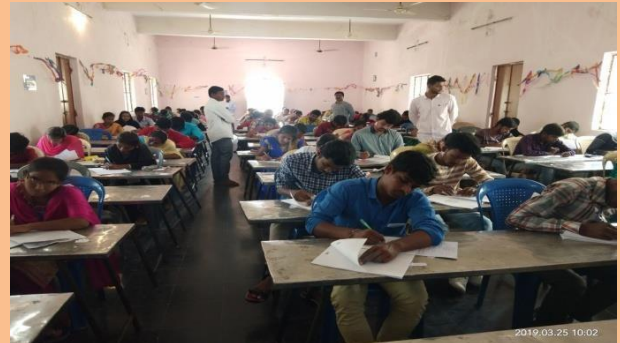
